

Our Team - On Time, On Budget and On Pointe

San Jose Dance Theatre operates as a 501(c)(3) not for-profit organization. The board is made up of professionals who are elected per nominated term. This structure complies with regulations surrounding nonprofit organizations.

With a diverse group of former dancers, members of the San Jose arts community and local business leaders, the SJDT board strives to provide the best overall dance experiences for both our dancers and our audiences while maintaining a strict fiscal responsibility to our investors and donors. We aim to always deliver on time training for our dancers, on budget productions for our patrons and do it all with a clear vision of our place in the community.

San Jose Dance Theatre employs a comprehensive marketing strategy

- **Social Media & Online Advertising:** We run consistent campaigns through social media and Google, promoting shows, educational programs, and general company news. With over 5,000 followers, our social media posts generate significant engagement.
- **Website:** Our regularly updated website provides key information on programs, events, and company news.
- **Email Marketing:** We send bi-weekly emails to over 10,000 subscribers, driving traffic to our website and correlating with ticket sales.
- Flyers & Posters: We distribute flyers and posters both online and in physical locations, including cafés and local venues, to enhance visibility.
- **In-Theater Marketing:** Flyers, posters, and digital promotions in theaters account for around 30% of our ticket sales.
- **Print & Online PR:** We advertise in industry-specific magazines and general media. Our PR efforts include newspaper features, interviews, and photo shoots, boosting brand exposure.
- Radio & Podcasts: Occasionally, we use radio advertising to reach older audiences for select performances.
